Serving with integrity and respect, this is a rewarding volunteer opportunity to contribute to the success of The GRAND. This is not just an oversight Board, when required the Board members contribute to the strategy and, depending on the situational requirements, the needs of the organization. Board member attendance is eleven Board meetings per year and eleven committee meetings, plus an Annual General Meeting.

There are five committees (Executive, Governance & HR, Finance & Risk, Grants & Fund Development and Artistic Direction), each Board member is expected to be an active participant in both Board and Committee meetings. We are specifically recruiting for a Finance & Risk committee member (experienced finance professional), and an Artistic Direction committee (experienced member of the arts community or background in the arts) and an individual with legal expertise.
